



WashSelect II PCI Compliance

Mandates issued by the credit card companies will soon require merchants to use payment applications that are compliant with the PCI Payment Application Data Security Standard (PA-DSS) or its predecessor standard, the Payment Application Best Practices standard (or PABP).

As the WashSelect II software does not include credit card processing functionality, a 3rd party payment device is added when credit card acceptance is required. To ensure compliance with the card company mandates, Unitec uses PABP validated devices for these applications. The device manufacturer is Datacap Systems and the specific product models and versions used are:

- Datatran SL Version 1.0 (for dial-up processing applications)
- IP Tran Version 3.00 (for Internet processing)

Both of these devices are included under Datacap Systems in the list of validated payment applications published by PCI at: <https://www.pcisecuritystandards.org>. Customers should identify the model and version of the Datacap credit processing device in use with their WashSelect when asked to identify the payment application used for credit processing.

It should also be noted that the WashSelect II must be operating with version 5.00 or later for PCI compliance. Software upgrades should be ordered through your Unitec distributor.
